How to connect...

- 1 Make sure your wireless adapter is turned on.
- 2 Select your building Wi-Fi from the list of available wireless networks and connect.
- 3 Wait about 30 seconds, then open your web browser. You will be redirected to a secure login page.
- 4 Click "New Users Sign Up Here" button to open new account and access the web.
- 5 Enjoy your time online with our Wi-Fi Internet.



How to connect...

Some computers connect automatically. The only thing that you have to do is make sure the wireless adapter in your computer is turned on. There should be a button with an indicator light near your keyboard. If you have trouble locating it, refer to the user's manual for the location.

iPad / iPod / iPhone

1. Go to "Settings" then "Wi-Fi" and make sure it is on.
2. Choose your building Wi-Fi and wait for check mark to appear next to the network name.
3. Login screen will load automatically in about 30 seconds.

Windows Vista

1. Go to "Start" and click on "Connect to".
2. Select your building Wi-Fi and click "Connect".
3. Click on "Connect Anyway" to the unsecured network. Your security and data encryption are handled on the server level.
4. Wait for "Successfully connected" message. You can save this network and close the window.

Windows 7

1. Click on network icon on the right of your bottom taskbar.
2. Select your building Wi-Fi from the list of available "Wireless Network Connections".
3. Check "Connect automatically" and click "Connect".

Mac OS X

1. Click on AirPort icon in taskbar on the top right corner of your screen.
2. Click on your building Wi-Fi. Check mark should appear next to it.

After successfully connecting to the wireless network please start your Internet browser (IE, FireFox, Chrome, Safari) and the login page will load automatically.
